2. Minutes of Annual Assembly 6 May 2009 were accepted and signed by the Chairman as a correct Record.
3. The Chairman presented her annual report (copy attached to the minutes) and thanked Rev Dixon for his regular attendance of KPC monthly meeting.
4. Public Questions:

Mr Waite queried which footpaths were being upgraded and was informed they were the end of Cautley Drive and Church Lane.

Mr Waite complimented KPC on the impressive survey results from Killinghall Moor.

Chair reported that Lund Lane footpath had now been completed.

Cllr Bellerby reported that the new signage on Crag Lane had little or no effect and that the police were not interested because unless the road was closed completely they could not do anything about it. Chair asked Clerk to report this to Highways.

Cllr J Hall reported that Woodsley Terrace residents had taken notice of the letter about parking on the pavements but Rev Dixon commented whilst this was better for pedestrians it was causing some concern to traffic coming down Otley Road.

Mr Waite asked if Highways could be contacted to remove the cone that the contractors had left outside Killinghall Bridge and the Clerk offered to do this. He also asked if any spare bulbs were available this year whether some could be planted near the new sign entering village from Ripley. Cllr J Hall proposed the gaps on Ripon Road beyond the Surgery could use some also. Last year however, although bulbs were ordered, KPC were not notified when they were available to collect.

Mr Waite also requested some varnish and a slat replacing on the seat at the War Memorial. Clerk would ask for this to be done.

Rev Dixon advised the meeting that HGVs were continuing to use Otley Road. He was advised that these vehicles were still being monitored for the Trading Standards by volunteers in the village undertaking a Lorry Watch.

The Chair thanked Cllrs for their support and the work of the Clerk during 2009/10.

Cllr J Stancombe proposed a vote of thanks to the Chair for her work during 2009/10.
